

## Mixed Media Collage Workshop - Kendra Postma

### **Supply list:**

- **Paint** – watercolors and acrylics - they can be the colors/brand you like to work with.
- **Scissors** – I like to use a tiny pair (love Tim Holtz brand) and a normal size.
- **X-Acto knife**
- **Matte medium** – Liquitex or Golden This is our “glue” and the final coat.
- **Watercolor paper** (I really like Bockingford #200) But if you are used to using a different brand that is fine. A variety of papers and weights is fine.
- **Good and old brushes**
- **Spectra Art white tissue paper:** If you have a friend taking, the class maybe you can share. You can find this on Amazon.
- **Pencils**, colored and or Caran D’Ache Pablo permanent-colored pencils (love these) You can buy a small set from Dick Blick. Amazon has only the large sets. Optional.
- **Acrylic Paint** – any brand is fine. Make sure you do have white and black.
- **Gesso** – White (this can be your white paint also)
- **Acrylic markers, metallic markers, permanent marker(s)**
- **Metal leaf and sizing.**
- **Color laser copy** of your teacup or coffee cup. 2-3 copies. If you only can get Inkjet that is okay, they might smear a bit is all.
- A verity **of handmade papers, fun images** of things you might put in the cup and images you just find fun and interesting. It could be papers that are just color and patterns, maps, old papers, just fill a large zip-lock bag and that is probably all you will need. Copies of things like tiny people, food, and plants. They can be the actual image if you don’t plan on ever using that image again.
- Please bring and only if you want to is 3-D small items to include with your collage in the shadow box. In the photo I used a little real bird egg that I found. Yes, it was empty!
- **Two pieces of foam core** at least 8x10

- **Small shadow box frame** 5x7 on up to 10x10, It's your choice. Can have glass or no glass. I have used a cradled panel and used the inside as my shadowbox.
- I will be bringing my Geli plates and stencils. You don't have to buy or bring yours unless you want to. I mainly use these with the white Spectra Art Tissue paper.
